#### Class Format

This version of **ABC3** is taught as a classroom experience with a live instructor. Because of the COVID-19 situation, it uses the Zoom platform for remote learning. America's Boating Club (ABC) has received approval for the "Emergency Virtual Classroom" format for the course from NASBLA.

Colorado regulations
(https://cpw.state.co.us/learn/Pages/BoatingSafetyCourses.aspx)) state that
"Individuals who are 14 and 15 and have successfully completed a state approved boating safely course can operate a motorized vessel in Colorado," but there are no course events scheduled.

According to the NASBLA representative for Colorado, the ABC3 course taught according to the Emergency Virtual Classroom standards meets Colorado approval. Parents or guardians are encouraged to participate during class sessions if they are interested in learning more about boating.

#### Class Details

The class meets on Tuesday evenings from 7-9 PM. The next course is scheduled to start Tuesday, January 19, 2021. It runs for four sessions of presentations plus the exam, finishing on February 16, 2021.

The classes use the Zoom teaching platform, so you will need access to a computer or mobile device that includes an internet connection and speakers or headphones, microphone, and webcam.

The cost is \$40 per person. This covers course materials and Zoom costs. The ABC-Certified Instructors are volunteer members of America's Boating Club – Colorado (ABC-CO). We are making arrangements for payment via Zelle or mailed check.
